THE TRIP

Itinerary overview

This cultural journey traces California's creative spine from Los Angeles to San Francisco along the Pacific Coast Highway, connecting artist colonies, historic missions, culinary destinations and dramatic coastal landscapes.

Designed for long-haul travelers seeking depth over distance, the

itinerary prioritizes longer stays in key destinations, allowing time to engage with local communities, creative traditions, and the landscapes that have inspired generations of artists, writers and filmmakers.



The Stats

Total Distance: Approximately 500 miles (805 km)

Total Driving Time: Approximately 15 hours (not including stops)

Recommended Duration: 9–10 nights

Route: Pacific Coast Highway (CA-1) and US-101

Trade Positioning: Ideal for travelers seeking a scenic, culturally rich California journey combining art, food, wine and coastal experiences with time to linger in each destination.

Essential Planning Notes:

- Verify Highway 1 accessibility through Big Sur prior to travel
- Reserve key experiences in advance (Hearst Castle, concerts, MICHELIN dining)
- Build flexibility for scenic stops, galleries, and local discoveries

Professional Tip for Advisors: Position this journey as an immersive road trip where the drive itself is a core experience, not simply transit between destinations.



● Day 1: Los Angeles to Ojai

Distance: 85 miles (137 km)

Driving Time: 1 hour 45 minutes

- After exploring Los Angeles' major arts institutions, travel north to Ojai, a tranquil artist enclave known for its exceptional light, creative heritage, and relaxed atmosphere. The town's galleries, outdoor bookstore, and farm-to-table dining scene offer an ideal introduction to California's creative culture.
- **Lodging:** Ojai Valley Inn · Capri Hotel · Ojai Rancho Inn

● Day 2-3: Ojai to Santa Barbara

Distance: 38 miles (61 km)

Driving Time: 50 minutes

- Spend two nights in Santa Barbara to experience its Spanish Colonial architecture, mission heritage, arts institutions, and coastal lifestyle. The Funk Zone district, waterfront promenades, and vibrant dining scene provide a balance of culture and leisure.
- **Lodging:** Hotel Californian · The Upham · Beachfront resorts



● Day 4: **Santa Barbara to Santa Ynez Valley or Cambria**

Distance: Approximately 95 miles (153 km)

Driving Time: Approximately 2.5 hours

- Travel through wine country into the Central Coast. Choose between a wine-focused overnight in Santa Ynez Valley or a coastal arts experience in Cambria, positioning travelers for the Big Sur drive.
- **Lodging:**
 - The Landsby · Hotel Ynez · Inn at Mattei's Tavern
 - Oceanpoint Ranch · El Colibri Hotel & Spa

● Day 5-6: **Cambria to Big Sur / Carmel**

Distance: ~70 miles (113 km)

Driving Time: ~2 hours

- Dedicate two nights to Big Sur or Carmel to fully experience California's most dramatic coastline. Visit Hearst Castle en route, then continue through iconic viewpoints, redwood groves, and coastal trails.
- **Lodging:** Alila Ventana Big Sur · Big Sur Lodge · Carmel boutique hotels



● Day 7–8: Big Sur to Santa Cruz

Distance: 75 miles (121 km)

Driving Time: Approximately 2 hours

- Continue north through Carmel to Santa Cruz, where surf culture, creative communities, and coastal scenery converge. Museums, local markets and outdoor activities offer an authentic perspective on California life.
- **Lodging:** Dream Inn · Hotel Paradox · West Cliff Inn

● Day 9+: Santa Cruz to San Francisco

Distance: 75 miles (121 km)

Driving Time: Approximately 1.5 hours

- Conclude in San Francisco, a global cultural capital known for its museums, neighborhoods, culinary excellence, and performing arts. Multiple nights allow for deeper exploration and optional day trips.
- **Lodging:** Luxury downtown hotels · Boutique neighborhood properties

- Designed for travelers who prefer immersion over fast-paced sightseeing.

- Emphasize flexibility – the itinerary can be shortened by removing one Central Coast stop.
